### BERGER SINGERMAN LLP'S FEE REPORT AND SUPPLEMENTAL OMNIBUS RESPONSE TO THE OBJECTIONS TO THE CONSERVATOR'S FEE REPORT

Berger Singerman LLP ("Berger Singerman") files this Fee Report and Supplemental Omnibus Response to the Objections to the Conservator's Fee Report. After more than a year of work by Berger Singerman on behalf of the Partnerships, Berger Singerman is now the only party that has not yet been approved for reimbursement for fees and costs incurred on behalf of the Partnerships – and that was recommended for such by the Conservator.

To the extent that this Court received objections to the Conservators' recommendation that the Partnerships reimburse Berger Singerman, they were either from defendants in lawsuits filed by the Partnerships, those affiliated with defendants, or individuals who filed letters with

this Court in response to a letter from Steve Jacob. Mr. Jacob's letter was replete with factual inaccuracies and wrongfully identified him as Managing General Partner of the Partnerships in contravention of this Court's Order Appointing Conservator. Ironically, those same individuals who filed objections based on Mr. Jacob's letter were, as alleged in a lawsuit approved by the Conservator, ripped off through the actions of Mr. Jacob and other defendants.

During a hearing on June 4, 2013, the Court suggested that fees and costs attributable to the filing of two lawsuits (the "Insider suit" and "Netwinner suit") on behalf of the Partnerships would not be paid at this time. However, the Court stated that Berger Singerman should be paid now for other fees and costs incurred on behalf of the Partnerships.

The Conservator – a neutral party that was suggested by more than one of the objectors – determined that Berger Singerman should be reimbursed for \$125,000 of its total fee request of \$173,191.71. Berger Singerman is hopeful that this Court will compensate it in the amount of \$125,000, which is a substantial reduction of its fee request of \$173,191.71 – which number is itself the result of substantially reduced hourly rates of \$300 per hour. Thus, approving reimbursement in the amount of \$125,000 is a substantial savings for the Partnerships.

Berger Singerman hopes that the Court recognizes, as the Conservator surely does, that Berger Singerman took numerous actions to preserve the rights and assets of the Partnerships, and the partners themselves. Berger Singerman expended substantial resources to remove the then-existing Managing General Partner, wrest documents from the Managing General Partner's control, seek the appointment of a replacement Managing General Partner, seek the appointment of a Conservator, and preserve substantial claims belonging to the Partnerships that may have otherwise expired. Berger Singerman also fought tirelessly to enforce orders entered by this Court that were ignored by others.

In light of the foregoing, and as detailed below, please consider this yet another request for prompt payment of substantially reduced costs and fees to Berger Singerman in the amount of \$125,000, and, in support, states:

#### <u>BACKGROUND</u>

This Court ordered Berger Singerman to identify the amount of fees and costs incurred for the work it performed on behalf of the Partnerships. Based on a review of Berger Singerman's invoice entries, Berger Singerman's work on behalf of the Partnerships can be separated into six buckets:

- (1) Work to remove Michael Sullivan ("Sullivan") as Managing General Partner of the Partnerships and replace him with a new Managing General Partner (**Exhibit A**);
- (2) Work to enforce this Court's Agreed Order dated August 29, 2012, whereby Sullivan resigned as Managing General Partner and whereby Margaret J. Smith ("Smith") was appointed as Managing General Partner, because certain individuals failed to abide by it (Exhibit B);
- (3) Work to appoint a Conservator for the Partnerships (Exhibit C);
- (4) Work to file the Insider suit and Netwinner suit (**Exhibit D**);
- (5) Work to transfer the pending lawsuits related to the Partnerships to this Court (Exhibit E);
- (6) Postage, reproduction, facsimile, and telephone call costs incurred in furtherance of Buckets 1 through 5 (Exhibit F).

The original invoices containing the entries comprising all of these buckets are attached hereto as **Exhibit**  $G^{-1}$ 

Although this Court suggested during a hearing on June 4, 2013, that fees and costs attributable to the filing of the Insider suit and Netwinner suit (Bucket 4) would not be paid at this time, the Court stated that Berger Singerman should be paid now for other fees and costs incurred on behalf of the Partnerships.

As set forth below, approval of reimbursing Berger Singerman for \$125,000 for the fees and costs it incurred on behalf of the Partnerships would be a substantial savings to the Partnerships, even for work that was unrelated to the filing of the Insider suit and Netwinner suit. Moreover, without Berger Singerman's work over the course of the last year, *inter alia*, a Conservator would never have been appointed, the Conservator would not be able to now pursue lawsuits that may recover millions of dollars for the Partnerships and the partners, and the Partnerships' assets may have been depleted by the former Managing General Partners.

Accordingly, for the reasons set forth below, Berger Singerman respectfully requests reimbursement from the Partnerships in the amount of \$125,000.

### A. BUCKET 1: WORK RELATED TO REMOVING SULLIVAN AS MANAGING GENERAL PARTNER AND REPLACING HIM WITH A NEW MANAGING GENERAL PARTNER.

The entries in Bucket 1 relate to fees and costs incurred by Berger Singerman to remove Sullivan based on the various improprieties uncovered and replace him with a new Managing General Partner.

Removing Sullivan and conducting an election for a new Managing General Partner appeared to be the most efficient way to prevent any further wrongdoings to the Partnerships. As set forth at length in previous filings, only after significant intransigence did Sullivan turn over an incomplete set of documents related to the Partnerships. With the help of GlassRatner, Berger Singerman then undertook an extensive forensic analysis that discovered various improprieties that were perpetuated upon the Partnerships and its partners. Due to those improprieties it was necessary to remove Sullivan as Managing General Partner.

The entries in Bucket 1 reflect the work necessary to remove and replace Sullivan. Entry numbers 1 through 85, 88, 89, 93 and others of **Exhibit A** demonstrate the extensive work necessary i) to ascertain the proper method for calling a special meeting and conducting a vote to remove Sullivan, ii) to identity of the partners of each Partnership who were entitled to notice of the special meeting and to vote, and iii) to conduct the special meeting on August 17, 2012. Once the relevant partners were identified, Berger Singerman was then required to provide notices and proxies to each of those partners, and Berger Singerman incurred significant postage and reproduction costs in doing so [See e.g. **Exhibit A**, entry numbers 7-33]. As evidence of the propriety of Berger Singerman's actions, at the special meeting, a majority of the outstanding Partnership interests voted in favor of replacing Sullivan with Smith and amending the Partnership Agreements to reflect that change.

The entries in Bucket 1 also reflect that after the vote, Berger Singerman was required to commence litigation to enforce the vote to remove and replace Sullivan. Despite the vote, Berger Singerman incurred fees and costs on behalf of the Partnerships because Sullivan refused to step down. For example, entry numbers 86, 87, 91, 92, 97 and later entries of **Exhibit A** reflect that Berger Singerman drafted a complaint, commenced the instant litigation against

Sullivan to enforce the vote of the Partners and protect the Partnerships, and prepared for an evidentiary hearing on the issue. In response, Sullivan, who was represented by counsel, agreed to resign as Managing General Partner. Then, on August 29, 2012, this Court entered an Agreed Order between the Plaintiffs and Sullivan (the "Agreed Order"). A copy of the Agreed Order is attached hereto as **Exhibit H**. Pursuant to that order, Sullivan resigned as Managing General Partner and Smith was deemed in his stead to be sole Managing General Partner of the Partnerships. *Id.* Smith, as managing general partner, was given "full access to all of the Partnership's books, records, assets and property and will be afforded all of the rights and duties of a Managing General Partner. ..." *Id.* Furthermore, Sullivan agreed that "he does not now and will not in the future challenge the appointment of Ms. Smith as Managing General Partner on August 17, 2012." *Id.* 

The fees incurred by Berger Singerman for work in Bucket 1 on behalf of the Partnerships amount to \$51,085.00 and the costs for work in Bucket 1 amount to \$3,517.99.

#### B. BUCKET 2: WORK TO ENFORCE THIS COURT'S AGREED ORDER.

The entries in Bucket 2 relate to fees and costs incurred by Berger Singerman to enforce the Agreed Order.

This Court's Agreed Order and Sullivan's resignation should have been the end of the matter, but certain individuals did not abide by it. Non-party Helen Chaitman ("Chaitman") and her law firm, Becker & Poliakoff, LLP ("Becker Poliakoff"), refused to recognize that Smith was the Managing General Partner. Chaitman would not turn over the Partnerships' funds to Smith and took unauthorized actions that forced Berger Singerman to take further actions on behalf of the Partnerships so that the Partnerships could obtain their property and operate.

As evidenced by the entries in Bucket 2, these actions by Berger Singerman, on behalf of

the Partnerships, included i) responding to a lawsuit that was originally initiated in Palm Beach County by Chaitman to distribute the Partnerships' funds to their partners but was later amended by Chaitman, without any apparent authority, to include a challenge to the vote electing Smith (see e.g., Exhibit B, entries 2, 5, 7, and 8); ii) terminating Chaitman and Becker Poliakoff as counsel to the Partnerships and demanding that they return all funds belonging to the Partnerships (see e.g., Exhibit B, entry 1); iii) filing a motion to compel Chaitman to immediately relinquish any partnership property that she was holding (see e.g., Exhibit B, entry 10); iv) responding to meritless allegations that the election of Smith was not proper (see e.g., Exhibit B, entries 9, 29, 33); and iv) preparing for and attending court hearings on these issues and others raised by papers filed by Chaitman and Becker Poliakoff (see e.g., Exhibit B, entries 33, 46, 49).

The fees related to work in Bucket 2 amount to <u>\$47,033.50</u>. The costs related to work in Bucket 2 amount to \$2,843.85.

#### C. BUCKET 3: WORK TO APPOINT A CONSERVATOR.

The entries in Bucket 3 comprise Berger Singerman's work to appoint a Conservator for the Partnerships (although initially identified as a Receiver).

Berger Singerman sought to appoint a Conservator because, despite this Court's Agreed Order, Chaitman and certain individuals continued to challenge Smith's appointment as Managing General Partner. As a result, the Partnerships could not operate. The inability to operate meant that the Partnerships could not pursue potential claims against Sullivan and others and potentially obtain any monies improperly gained from them. This issue was even more urgent because, as of December 2012, the statute of limitations on those claims was potentially

drawing to a close.<sup>2</sup>

The entries in Bucket 3 reflect Berger Singerman's efforts to appoint a Conservator to

manage the Partnerships and quiet any further challenges to their operation. Berger Singerman's

Motion to Appoint a Receiver was inexplicably opposed by Chaitman, who at this point,

represented absolutely no one in connection with the underlying proceedings. Chaitman's

baffling opposition necessitated further work Berger Singerman, and required Berger Singerman

to argue in favor of appointing a Conservator at a hearing before this Court. See e.g., Exhibit C,

entry 40. It was only after this Court questioned Becker Poliakoff that they seemed to realize

that a Conservator was necessary due to the ongoing disputes that Chaitman and others had

manufactured:

MR. ROSEN:

It's messy. It's

absolutely messy. There's no question

about it.

See Hearing Transcript from December 18, 2012, at 40:3-5, attached hereto as Exhbit I. As a

result, the Court agreed with Berger Singerman that it was necessary to appoint a Conservator for

the Partnerships, despite the extensive argument in opposition, and after Berger Singerman

incurred considerable expenses in researching and preparing for a hearing on that issue.

Berger Singerman incurred additional fees and costs by preparing the initial draft of the

Order Appointing Conservator, which was circulated for comment among the various parties.

On January 17, 2013, this Court signed the Order Appointing Conservator (the "Conservator

Order") after comment from the various parties who appeared by counsel – even though

Chaitman opposed it.

The fees incurred by Berger Singerman for work in Bucket 3 amount to \$44,059,50. The

costs related to work in Bucket 3 amount to \$1,565.35.

#### D. BUCKET 4: THE NETWINNER SUIT AND INSIDER SUIT

The entries related to the Netwinner suit and Insider suit comprise Bucket 4.

The remaining objections to Berger Singerman's fees and costs seem focused on Berger Singerman's work in filing the Netwinner suit and Insider suit. The objectors (whom include defendants in one of the actions) believe that those fees and costs should be subject to an *ex post facto* contingency agreement, even though any such contingency agreement was never contemplated when the actions were filed. It was only after the Conservator was appointed that Berger Singerman was asked to represent the Partnerships on a contingency basis.

The fees incurred by Berger Singerman for work in Bucket 4 amount to <u>\$18,020.00</u>. The costs incurred by Berger Singerman for work in Bucket 4 amount to <u>\$1,711.91</u>. The time entries reflecting that work are set forth on **Exhibit D**.

### E. BUCKET 5: BERGER SINGERMAN INCURRED FEES AND EXPENSES TO TRANSFER ALL LITIGATION RELATED TO THE PARTNERSHIPS TO THIS COURT.

The entries in Bucket 5 relate to fees and costs incurred by Berger Singerman to transfer pending litigation related to the Partnerships to this Court.

Aside from this action, three separate lawsuits were filed that related to the Partnerships. First, an action was filed by Chaitman in Palm Beach County to determine the proper method of distributing the Partnerships' funds to their partners. Berger Singerman incurred fees and costs transferring that lawsuit to this Court. Second, the Netwinner and Insider suits were not filed by the clerk in the Complex Litigation Division, even though both cases were filed with a Civil Cover Sheet specifying that they were to be filed in the Complex Litigation Division. An administrative error is the only reason that the cases were not initially filed in the Complex

Litigation Division. Unfortunately, these transfers required Berger Singerman to file motions to

transfer those actions and attend hearings in furtherance of those motions.

The fees incurred by Berger Singerman for work in Bucket 5 amount to \$2,720.00 and

the time entries reflecting that work are set forth in Exhibit E.

F. BUCKET 6: POSTAGE, REPRODUCTION, FACSIMILE, AND TELEPHONE CALLS COSTS INCURRED IN FURTHERANCE OF BUCKETS 1 THROUGH 5.

The entries in Bucket 6 reflect costs incurred by Berger Singerman in furtherance of the

work described in Buckets 1 through 5. These costs include postage (\$1,626.52), reproduction

(\$13,423.80), facsimile (\$41.00), and long distance telephone calls (\$23.00).

Unfortunately, these costs are not attached to any description, and therefore the specific

component of work attached to these costs is not readily identifiable. However, the dates of the

costs reveal their importance. For example, entry 12 of Exhibit F for \$8,128 for "reproductions"

and entry 8 of Exhibit F for 953.12 for "postage" were incurred during the time of the special

meeting in August 17, 2012. Those costs reflect the work necessary to copy hundreds of notices

and proxies that were then sent to the relevant partners of the Partnerships. Without those costs,

Sullivan would never have been removed. The other costs reflected in Bucket 6 were similarly

incurred on behalf of the Partnerships and were necessary to conduct the work described in

Buckets 1 through 5.

The costs incurred by Berger Singerman for work in Bucket 6 amount to: \$15,114.32.

CONCLUSION

Without considering the fees and costs incurred by Berger Singerman in filing the

Netwinner suit and Insider suit (Bucket 4), the total amount of fees and costs for Buckets 1, 2, 3,

5, and 6 is as follows:

Bucket 1:

Total Amount of Fees and Costs for Buckets 1, 2, 3, 5, and 6 = \$154,504.35.

Despite a total amount of fees and costs incurred of \$154,504.35 for work in Buckets 1, 2, 3, 5, and 6, the total amount requested here by Berger Singerman is \$125,000.00, an amount which was recommended by the Conservator, and which represents a significant savings to the Partnerships. Accordingly, and for the above reasons, Berger Singerman respectfully requests that the Court approve and order reimbursement by the Partnerships to Berger Singerman in the amount of \$125,000.

WHEREFORE, Berger Singerman respectfully requests that all objections to reimbursement of fees and costs to Berger Singerman be denied in their entirety, that the Court approve and order reimbursement by the Partnerships to Berger Singerman in the amount of \$125,000.00 as set forth in the Proposed Order attached as **Exhibit J**, and that the Court grant such other and further relief as the Court deems necessary.







# AGREED ORDER RESOLVING PLAINTIFFS' EMERGENCY MOTION FOR TEMPORARY INJUNCTION

THIS CAUSE came before the Court on Plaintiffs' Emergency Motion for Temporary Injunction, and this Court having been advised of an agreement between the parties and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, it is hereby ORDERED that:

- 1. This Order implements the agreement of the Parties and is entered on an agreed basis.

  Plaintiffs' Emergency Motion for Temporary Injunction is resolved as provided herein.
- 2. Defendant Michael D. Sullivan ("Defendant") shall resign as Managing General Partner of both P&S Associates, General Partnership ("P&S") and S&P Associates, General Partnership ("S&P") (together with P&S, the "Partnerships"), and consents to the appointment of Margaret J. Smith ("Ms. Smith") as Managing General Partner in his



- stead. Plaintiffs' agreement to allow Defendant to resign is not a waiver of any positions asserted in this action.
- 3. Ms. Smith is deemed the Managing General Partner of the Partnerships effective upon entry of this Order and will remain as such unless and until she withdraws from her role as Managing General Partner, or is removed consistent with the terms of the Partnership Agreements.
- 4. As Managing General Partner, Ms. Smith will be given full access to all of the Partnerships' books, records, assets and property and will be afforded all of the rights and duties of a Managing General Partner, including but not limited to those contemplated by Article 8.02 of each of the Partnerships' respective Partnership Agreements.
- 5. Defendant does not now and will not in the future challenge the appointment of Ms. Smith as Managing General Partner on August 17, 2012. Defendant agrees that he is no longer authorized to act in any capacity as Managing General Partner of the Partnerships, and is to direct all Partnership business to Ms. Smith. In so consenting to his withdrawal as Managing General Partner, Defendant reserves all other rights and defenses, and such consent to Ms. Smith's appointment shall not be deemed or considered an admission of liability either on his own behalf or on behalf of any of his employees, affiliates, assigns or agents.
- 6. The Parties further reserve all rights with respect to the action styled P&S Associates, et al. v. Roberta Alves, et al., Case No. 2012CA013587, currently pending in the Circuit Court of the 15<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit in and for Palm Beach County (the "Interpleader Case"). Defendant may not act as representative or Managing General Partner of the Partnerships with respect to that action. However, the Parties specifically agree, as a condition of the

relief provided herein, that the Interpleader Case will not be unilaterally dismissed by Ms. Smith in her capacity as the Managing General Partner of the Partnerships. Without prejudice to the rights of the Managing General Partner pursuant to paragraphs 7.05 and 8.02 of the Partnership Agreements, it is the intent of the Parties that the Interpleader Action provide the basis for the methodology used to determine how distributions will be made to partners, *i.e.*, without limitation, based on the amount in the partner's capital account (last statement balance), in the amount of the net investment of the account holder over the life of the account, or based on other equitable principles. Plaintiffs reserve all defenses to the Interpleader Action, and do not, by virtue of this Order, concede that venue in Palm Beach County is appropriate.

- 7. On or before September 5, 2012, Defendant shall provide to Ms. Smith all books and records not previously provided to Plaintiffs or their representatives, including electronic records of the Partnerships. Subject to Defendant's right to raise any written objection under the Florida Rules of Civil Procedure, Defendant shall provide the books and records of JS&P Associates, General Partnership, and SPJ Investments, Ltd. Defendant has represented that he does not have custody, possession or control of the books or records, electronic or otherwise, of Guardian Angel Trust, LLC. Defendant further agrees to use his best efforts to insure an efficient, orderly and smooth transition from his role as Managing General Partner to Ms. Smith's role as Managing General Partner.
- 8. This case is hereby stayed pending further order of the Court, but for a period of not less than 60 days, without prejudice to the rights of any parties to this action. This stay will be lifted upon a motion by either party.

- 9. This Order is binding on all Parties, including Ms. Smith, who is not a named party but has submitted herself to the jurisdiction of this Court by accepting the appointment as Managing General Partner as provided in paragraph 3 above.
- 10. Defendant, by agreeing to the terms of this Order specifically denies and does not admit any liability or wrongdoing and nothing in this Order shall constitute any finding of liability or wrongdoing either by Defendant or any of his employees, affiliates, assigns or agents. It is Defendant's position that he has agreed to the relief herein to preserve the resources of the Partnerships.

#### **ORDERED** and **ADJUDGED** as follows:

1. The recommendations of the Fee Report as to Berger Singerman LLP ("Berger Singerman") are approved in all respects.

2. The Conservator shall promptly make a distribution to Berger Singerman in the amount of \$125,000 out of the Partnerships' assets, with such distributions being allocated to each of the Partnerships equally.

3. The fees and costs recommended by the Conservator for Berger Singerman are found to be reasonable considering each and every factor contemplated by *Florida Patient's Compensation Fund v. Rowe*, 472 So. 2d 1145 (Fla. 1985) and the principles of *Lewis v. Gramil Corp.*, 94 So. 2d 174, 177 (Fla. 1957).
