ORDER ABATING ALL NON-ADMINISTRATIVE FUNCTIONS OF CASE

THIS MATTER came before the Court on July 2, 2013, upon the Conservator, Philip von Kahle's July 1, 2013 Case Management Conference Responses (the "Response"). The Court having reviewed the Response and the record in this case, having heard argument and proffer of counsel, being otherwise familiar with the instant matter and those certain related matters presently pending before this court, finding it necessary to keep the instant matter open to allow the Conservator to administer the Conservatorship, and for the reasons stated on the record, it is

ORDERED and **ADJUDGED** as follows:

1. Until further order of this Court, this case shall be abated for all but administrative purposes.
2. Administrative purposes include, but are not limited to, any and all functions that would allow the Conservator to completely and effectively carry out any duty imposed or exercise any power granted by the Order Appointing Conservator (the "Conservatorship Order") entered in this case on January 17, 2013, including, among other things, filing interim and final reports, managing, winding-down, preserving, maintaining, protecting and administering the Conservatorship Property,¹ attending status conferences and advising this Court and the parties-

in-interest of the status of this case or the related cases, submitting fee applications and requests for reimbursement of costs for himself and for professionals and agents engaged by the Conservator, and reviewing, prosecuting, dismissing, initiating and/or investigating any and all of the Partnerships'² assets, claims, potential claims or causes of action that may be brought or have been brought on behalf of the Partnerships.

3. This Order is without prejudice to the Conservator or other party-in-interest to seek further guidance, modification, or expansion of the Order Appointing Conservator, to seek any other further relief as may be necessary, or to terminate the abatement imposed by this Order.
